

OKLAHOMA

Birch Creek & Lake

Birch Lake, 1,137 acres, 27 miles of shoreline, on Birch Creek in Osage County, OK. One half mile south of Barnsdall, 20 miles southwest of Bartlesville, north of Skiatook on Hwy 11. Has large & smallmouth, spotted & hybrid striped bass, walleye, black & white crappie, channel & flathead catfish & sunfish.

Turn west on West Chestnut Avenue in Barnsdall. At the end of the street, turn south on 8th Street. Turn west on access road 2420, then south on CR 2471.

1 Loop north of lake up around Birch Creek.

Turn west on West Chestnut Avenue in Barnsdall. At the end of the street, turn south on 8th Street. 8th Street becomes CR 2409.

2 **Dam is off CR 2409.** Fish tailwater below dam.

3 **North Rec area Ramp.** Kayak Right. Following shore takes you to Birch Creek.

4 **South Rec area Ramp by Beach.** Kayak Left.
